

## Passenger Numbers at Jaipur International Airport Grow 14 Percent in December '24 over December '23. Jaipur handles highest passenger load ever

- *In December '24, Jaipur International Airport recorded passenger traffic of over 5.9 Lakhs, reflecting an increase of approximately 14% compared to December '23 (5.1 Lakhs); Domestic passengers increased by 11%, while international travelers increased by 56%*
- *Single day traffic constantly hovered around 2018 and above in the month of December*
- *Crossed 50 thousand international passenger traffic, first time post covid era in December' 24*

**Jaipur, Rajasthan:** Jaipur International Airport (JAI) continues its impressive growth in passenger traffic during December 2024. JAI Airport recorded passenger traffic of over 5.9 Lakhs, reflecting an increase of approximately 14% when compared to December 2023. This includes 5.3 Lakhs domestic travelers and 50307 international travelers which is the first-time post covid era. The significant hike in passenger traffic at Jaipur Airport reflects travelers' confidence in the airport's world-class facilities and services, as well as the connectivity that the Airport offers.

Compared to the previous month of November 2024, passenger traffic at Jaipur International Airport rose by 6 percent in December 2024. During this period, domestic passengers and international passengers increased by 5% and 14% percent, respectively.

With increasing passenger load and the opening of new routes, airlines are adding more flights to various domestic destinations. As a result, the Air Traffic Movement, too, remained high at 4776 in December 2024. International Air Traffic movement registered a growth of 41% in December 24 over December 23. The massive growth was due to Salam airways reviving its operations from Jaipur and Etihad airways operating additional flights for Abu-Dhabi. Currently, Jaipur International Airport offers direct connectivity to 25 domestic cities and six international destinations.

The overall growth in passenger numbers reaffirms the Airport's commitment to providing global connectivity, a seamless travel experience and world class service to passengers. Prioritizing safety and security, Jaipur International Airport ensures a smooth and convenient experience for all travelers. As Jaipur Airport continues to achieve new heights, it remains dedicated to exceeding passenger expectations and setting new standards of excellence in the global aviation sector.
