

## Jaipur International Airport Enhances Preparedness for Upcoming Low Visibility Period

**Jaipur, 25 November 2025** – Jaipur International Airport Limited (JIAL) has undertaken proactive preparedness measures to enable smooth and uninterrupted flight operations for passengers and airlines, with the upcoming winter season where low visibility conditions usually lead to delays and cancellations of flights.

Jaipur International Airport's infrastructure places it among the few airports in the region designed to handle operations under extreme low visibility conditions. The airport supports CAT III ILS (Instrument Lighting System), one of the most advanced navigation systems that allows aircraft to land and take-off safely in extreme low visibility conditions. Complementing this system is the advanced Approach Lighting System (ALS) and Runway Lighting System, which provides visual guidance to pilots during flight operations.

Beyond technological readiness, Jaipur International Airport has carried out detailed ground preparations, including fresh runway markings, thorough maintenance of runway lights and approach lights and deployed additional on-ground manpower to facilitate aircraft's seamless operations during the low visibility conditions.

Owing to its technological capabilities, Jaipur Airport has become a hub for diverted flights. The airport successfully accommodated over 80 diversions from nearby airports last year during the low visibility period (between December 2024 and February 2025), underscoring its reliability and operational resilience.
